Re: Street, Curb and Gutter Project – Improvements on Bridgetown Bend

Dear Resident:

The City of Coronado has contracted with TC Construction Company to construct the annual Street, Curb and Gutter project. This year, the project includes roadway improvements on Port Royale Road, St. Kitt's Way and portions of Bridgetown Bend.

Construction on Bridgetown Bend involves removing the existing asphalt pavement, recompacting the subgrade and placing new asphalt pavement. The limits of the work are from 35-41 Bridgetown Bend.

Traffic control and detour plans are still being finalized, however, this section of Bridgetown Bend will be closed during pavement removal and replacement. The closure will be during daytime working hours (typically from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.) but will be open by the end of each work day. However, local traffic will be able to access the Port Royale Village at all times via signed detour routes used as needed. Waste collection will not be disrupted during the construction of this project.

Construction is expected to begin on October 10, 2017, and be completed by October 27, 2017. Shortly after the completion of this project, the entire segment of Bridgetown Bend will be slurry sealed as part of the City's Preventive Maintenance project. For each project, the contractors will deliver door hangers a minimum of three days prior to work taking place on your street to notify you of the upcoming construction. Traffic control and detour plans are still being finalized, however, the affected streets will be partially and/or fully closed during daytime working hours (typically from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.) and will be open by the end of each work day. Local traffic will be able to access the Port Royale Village at all times via signed detour routes, as needed. Waste collection will not be disrupted during the construction of this project.

Construction is expected to begin on October 10, 2017, and be completed by October 27, 2017. The contractor will deliver door hangers a minimum of three days prior to work taking place on your street to notify you of the upcoming construction.
