



CITY OF CORONADO

The following tips are steps you can take to help prevent pollution from entering the storm drain system and reaching our beaches and bay:

Reduce overspray irrigation. Direct or readjust nozzles to landscaped areas, or hand water.

Clean up after your pets. Seal pet waste in plastic bags and place into a trash receptacle.

Dry-sweep debris from sidewalks or driveways. Remove materials from hardscape areas and properly dispose materials in trash receptacle.

Maintain your vehicle in good condition. Fix oil leaks. Use absorbent materials, such as cat litter or pads to clean up spills then take them to the City's household hazardous waste facility. Recycle motor oil and other hazardous materials.

Throw your waste in proper receptacles. Collect solid waste and place it in the appropriate trash receptacle with a lid.

Landscaping pesticides and chemicals. Follow the manufacturer's directions carefully, use sparingly and avoid over-watering when using fertilizers, pesticides and herbicides.

Try nontoxic products. Purchase only the amount of household product you need. Dispose of any remaining household hazardous waste properly at Public Services, 101 B Ave., on most Saturdays from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m.
